Check out this short video guide to locate Repeat Balls, Timer Balls, and Net Balls in Pokemon Omega Ruby and Alpha Sapphire! These special Pokeballs can be tricky to find since you gotta remember to chat with the scientist on Route 116 first. After that, the second clerk will pop up at the Pokemart in Rustboro City - make sure to like this vid if it helped! To get your hands on these balls, here's what you need to know: Timer Balls are available for purchase at the Pokemart in Rustboro City, but only after talking to the Devon employee on Route 116. You can also try beating Pokémon Ranger Catherine or Jackson in a rematch on Route 119 - they'll give you a Timer Ball as a reward! But let's be real, buying them from the mart is way easier and more reliable. Here's how to do it: 1. Start by heading to Route 116 in Rustboro City. 2. Talk to the Devon employee near the cave where you rescued Peeko - he'll give you a Repeat Ball. 3. Go back to the Pokemart in Rustboro City, and a second clerk should appear - now you can buy Timer Balls! Some quick stats: I've got 33,529,682 views on Pokémon Omega Ruby and Alpha Sapphire across 648 vids - that's a lot of gaming content! You might want to challenge Pokémon Rangers Jackson and Catherine for a rematch, indicated by the "Battle Ready" sign next to them on Route 119. After defeating them again, they have a 20% chance of giving you a Timer Ball. To find both Pokémon Rangers: Start at Route 119's south entrance then head north until you see Catherine near the river. For Jackson, head east and up the stairs, cross the bridge going west, and head north past the tall grass to find him. After beating them in a rematch, they will give you a Timer Ball with a 20% chance. Poke Ball Types and Catch Rates There are several types of Poke Balls available in the game, each with its own unique characteristics and catch rates. - \*\*Ball 1000\*\*\*: A basic Poke Ball that has a 3.5x catch rate when used while Surfing, Fishing, or Diving underwater. - \*\*Dusk Ball 1000\*\*\*: A Poke Ball that has a 3.5x catch rate in caves or at night. - \*\*Luxury Ball 1000\*\*\*: A comfortable Poke Ball with a 1x catch rate that can make wild Pokemon grow friendlier after being caught. - \*\*Heal Ball 300\*\*\*: A remedial Poke Ball with a 1x catch rate that restores HP and eliminates status conditions. Poke Balls are available for purchase in specific locations, including Fallarbor Town and Verdanturf Town. Some Poke Balls have unique properties that make them more effective in certain situations. - \*\*Nest Ball 1000\*\*\*: A Poke Ball with a max catch rate of 4x when used to catch wild Pokemon at lower levels. - \*\*Net Ball 1000\*\*\*: A Poke Ball with a 3x catch rate for Water- and Bug-type Pokemon. - \*\*Repeat Ball 1000\*\*\*: A Poke Ball that increases its catch rate by 3x when catching a previously caught Pokemon species. - \*\*Quick Ball 1000\*\*\*: A Poke Ball with a 5x catch rate when used at the start of battle. - \*\*Timer Ball 1000\*\*\*: A Poke Ball with varying catch rates based on the turn number it's used in.
