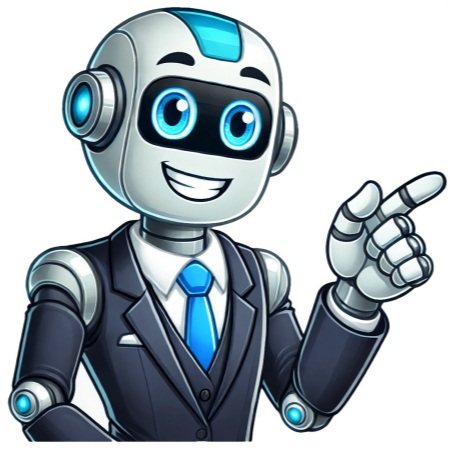

If the information in the AIS is incorrect, taxpayers should contact the reporting entity immediately and keep necessary documentation to prove the incorrect transaction does not belong to them. The AIS is a comprehensive database already present with the department, making it difficult for taxpayers to hide any information. To access the AIS, taxpayers need to log in to the income tax website, click on the "Annual Information Statement" tab, select the relevant financial year, and download the PDF or other formats such as JSON or CSV. The downloaded PDF will be password-protected, requiring the taxpayer's PAN in lower case, date of incorporation or formation for non-individual taxpayers, or date of birth for individual taxpayers to open it.
