I have an issue with my HyperX Quadcast (First Gen) mic. Sometimes I scream loudly into it and it limits perfectly, but when I go high pitched, it picks up my screaming in a deep voice instead of the high pitch. It's hard to explain, but I've uploaded a video on YouTube showing what this looks like. Has anyone encountered something similar? As a gamer, I know how important it is to have a good yell. But if your vocal cords are on strike, don't worry! There are several reasons why you might be unable to scream, mostly due to vocal cord issues. Vocal abuse like screaming too much can cause swollen vocal cords, immediate inflammation and swelling leading to hoarseness or complete loss of voice. It also causes vocal nodules calluses that form on your vocal cords from repeated abuse making it hard for them to vibrate properly. Vocal polyps are softer growths that develop on the vocal cords from vocal abuse, affecting one cord sometimes. Laryngitis is inflammation of the larynx (voice box), often caused by a viral infection like cold or flu, or allergies and irritants. It causes hoarseness, loss of voice, sore throat, and dry cough. GERD, asthma, allergies, and neurological disorders can also indirectly affect your vocal cords. As we age, our vocal cords lose elasticity and mass, leading to a weaker voice and decreased ability to reach high pitches or scream with the same power as before. Resting your voice is the most important step! Avoid talking, singing, or screaming as much as possible. Hydrate by drinking plenty of water, humidify using a humidifier especially in dry climates, and avoid irritants like smoke. Losing your ability to scream can be a frustrating experience for gamers and music enthusiasts alike. However, with the right knowledge and care, you can regain your vocal roars and dominate the gaming world (or karaoke stage). If you're experiencing loss of screaming ability due to prolonged shouting or excitement during intense gaming sessions, take steps to rest and recover your vocal cords. Stay hydrated, warm up your voice beforehand with gentle exercises, avoid excessive screaming, and take frequent breaks to allow your vocal cords to repair themselves. In some cases, vocal abuse can lead to the formation of vocal nodules, which restrict the vocal cords' ability to vibrate at high frequencies. Consult a vocal coach specializing in extreme vocals for guidance on proper technique and breathing control. Chronic vocal abuse can result in permanent damage, such as scarring or persistent nodules, leading to a permanently altered or weakened voice. However, by taking proactive steps to protect your voice during gaming sessions or concerts, you can minimize the risk of long-term damage. It seems like my mic is being a bit finicky. Even with the filters tweaked, there's an issue when I try to get high-pitched sounds through. Weirdly enough, it picks up lower frequencies just fine, but those squeaky high notes are nowhere to be found. I've uploaded a video on YouTube that might help illustrate the problem. Does anyone know what could be causing this or if I'm doing something wrong? I'm using the HyperX Quadcast (First Gen) and have tried tweaking the settings, but nothing seems to work. One possible solution that was suggested is reworking the noise-cancelling filter or low-pass filter on my mic to allow higher frequencies through, but this would also let some background noise get picked up - namely the hum of my computer fan. What do you think I should try? Should I mess with the filters or look elsewhere for the issue?
