No, it is not.There is no way round the back.This is not the way (but there is another way).I will not come.Oh, no!No, thank you.Not on my watch!I can not go anywhere.Examples of improper usage of "No" and "Not":That is no the way you do it.Oh not!I know how to tie a knot. (Disambiguation)I didn't no that!I can no go.Not way!When there are multiple "no's" in a sentence, if the number of "no's" is even then the "no's" together mean "yes" (because when saying "no no", the first no cancels the second no).
