CrosshairToggle the crosshair feature on or off. The crosshair is useful for precise analysis as it helps track exact data points on both the price and time axes.

Price LineEnable the price line to see the current price level of the asset displayed on the chart. This feature helps in identifying the real-time market price on your chart.

Day BreaksEnable or disable day breaks to mark the start of a new trading day. Day breaks can help in distinguishing different trading sessions on intraday charts.

Grid LinesToggle the visibility of grid lines on the chart. You can also adjust the grid line style to make the chart more organized and easier to interpret.

Your paid account is tagged to a combination of your Email ID and the login method. Example: Using the same Gmail ID on the two login methods will create two unique accounts on GoCharting, and your paid account will be tagged to the one you used while making the payment.

How to Create an Account on GoCharting**Visit the Homepage:** Open a web browser and go to the GoCharting website. **Locate the Login Button:** On the top-right corner of the homepage, you will see a Login button. Click on it to proceed. **Sign-Up Option:** Once you click on Login, you will be presented with options to either log in to an existing account or sign up for a new account. Follow the prompts to create a new account.

This is especially useful for algorithmic and discretionary traders who want to be notified instantly when their conditions are fulfilled. **Basic Usage Example**Here is an example where we create an alert when RSI crosses above 70: **How to Use Alerts in GoCharting** Write Your Script Open the Lipi Script editor and define your conditions using the function. Save and add the script to your chart. On the GoCharting platform, open the Alert Widget from the right panel or right click on the chart and click on alert. **Set Up the Alert**Choose your script from the list of available indicators. Select the alert message (defined in your script). **Configure notification preferences** (sound, popup, webhook, etc.). **Set it live.** Receive Alerts Instantly Whenever your scripts condition is met, the alert will trigger automatically. **Key Notes** runs every bar and triggers when the condition inside it is met.
