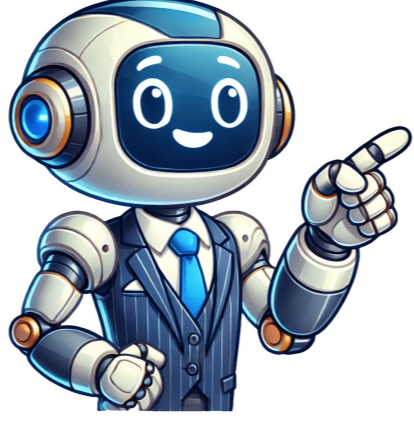

Two sisters, Jeevika and Manvi live in Rishikesh with their family. Jeevika is sweet, righteous and mature, and is a teacher in a neighbouring school. Her younger sister, Manvi, fresh out of college, is carefree, rebellious, childish and immature. Chandrika, their grandmother receives marriage proposal for Jeevika from Vadhers in Chandigarh. Jeevika loves Dr. Manan, but sides with Chandrika despite her feelings for Manan. The Vadhers' sons, Viren and Virat, meet Jeevika and Manvi. Viren meets Jeevika and falls for her and they marry. After a series of incidents, Virat and Manvi bond with each other. Soon after, Manvi is diagnosed with cancer. But she decides not to disclose it to Jeevika or her new family. Only Virat learns of her sickness. Around the same time, Jeevika faces an accident during her stay at Rishikesh. Viren asks Manvi to donate her blood, but she refuses leaving Viren furious. However, as time went on, the character of Maanvi underwent a significant transformation, becoming more likable and endearing to audiences.[6] Despite this positive turn, the show ultimately came to an abrupt close due to creative differences between the production house and the channel, with Siddharth Malhotra stating that the cast was unwilling to age on screen.[7] The Indian Express gave the show a mediocre rating of two stars, praising the chemistry between D'Souza and Sharma but criticizing the lackluster writing. However, in a surprise twist, the show announced its return for a sequel in January 2021. The show's awards and nominations list is impressive, with Kushal Tandon winning several accolades for his portrayal of Ranveer Singh, including Best Debut (Male) at the Gold Awards. Nia Sharma also took home the award for Best Actress Drama at the Indian Television Academy Awards, while Krystle D'Souza was nominated in the same category. The show was recognized by numerous critics and audiences alike, earning several nominations and wins across various categories.
