Pokemon brick bronze route 14

The Pokémon Brick Bronze walkthrough is a detailed guide for players to progress through the game. It is written in a casual style to help players navigate the game's hints and progression. Please note that this walkthrough contains major spoilers.

Route The Pokémon in Roria's Normal Adventure Mode are listed below. However, roaming Pokémon not included in this table have fixed levels of 40 and a 0.1% chance to appear anywhere in the region using wild encounter methods specified earlier. Trainers on the route offer various rewards for battling them.
Trainer Mountaineer Zach: Snorunt (Ice-type, Level 55), Swinub (Ice/Ground-type, Level 55), Piloswine (Ice/Ground-type, Level 56)

Items that can be found in Roria include the Never-Melt Ice item ball behind a cabin on this route and Sceptilite C given by a man under Christmas Tree after completing a past event. Other items include TM7 (Ice/Hail) near the frozen lake, TM102 (Water/Waterfall) inside the frozen waterfall.
Trivia: Battling Mountaineer Tawnya is an effective way to train HP, while Adventurer Tanner offers EXP and Physical Attack training opportunities.
The mysterious Route 217 leads further downwards with the ominous phrase "Route 217" etched into its surface. Although resembling Sinnoh Route 217, this route is situated on lower ground and boasts more treacherous conditions due to persistent blizzards. A notable Trainer named Darren shares a similar name and class with one on Route 11 but rewards an impressive amount of money, despite his apparent lack of recognition towards the player. A mistake by the developers has resulted in Darren being unavailable for rematches, preventing him from taking over as the primary hotspot for financial gain. This error stems from mismanaged Trainer names rather than a deliberate intention to make Darren a recurring character, unlike Interviewers Gabby and Ty in Hoenn.
On this route, Eevee's evolution into Glaceon is unlocked, while Crawbravler evolves into Crabominable when leveled up. Interestingly, Route 15 was once used as a portal for Shadow Void access during the 2017 Halloween Event.
Route 14 consists of two parts: an abandoned city with ancient ruins and a partly frozen cave leading to Route 15. Notably, Crystal Onix is said to have destroyed the city centuries ago, only to reappear in the wild with an extremely rare encounter rate. It also serves as a "Shiny-locked" Pokémon, meaning there's no Shiny version available. The area has a rich history, as three Protectors once faced off against the Crystal Beast during its rampage. The beast was eventually defeated, but not before the Titan returned to its slumber. A mysterious door at the top of Route 14 remains, bearing the phrase "The Three Protectors will awaken the Titan." Obtaining the first three Legendary Titans can unlock access to Titans' Throng, where the final Titan awaits the player's arrival. The player's attempt to recruit Rival Tess fails as she refuses to join an evil organization. The player then defeats two Grunts, but things take a surprising turn when the Eclipse Admin reveals himself and starts discussing reuniting with Tess and the player. A shocking plot twist unfolds as the admin is finally revealed.
Meanwhile, notes on various Pokémon's rarity levels, encounter rates, and recommended Poké Balls are provided, including information on walking cave encounters and roaming Pokémon in Normal Adventure Mode.
Route 14 is a challenging adventure mode route that connects Fluoruma City to Route 15. To progress, players must obtain the Harvest Badge and a Pokémon with HM8 Rock Climb. The route is divided into two parts: the first part features abandoned ruins of an old city destroyed by Crystal Onix over a century ago, attracting tourists and historians from Roria. The second part is a partly frozen cave leading to Route 15. Players must be cautious as Crystal Onix is reported to have reawakened and attacked some miners on this route. It has a rare encounter rate of 1/1600 (0.0625%) and is considered the rarest Wild Pokémon in-game, making it "Shiny-locked". There is no Shiny version of Crystal Onix. The city was destroyed by the Crystal Beast over a century ago on Route 14 and the people called upon the 3 Protectors to wake up the Titan. A great match between the Crystal Beast and the Titan ensued, resulting in the defeat of the Crystal Beast which then fled. The Titan returned to its slumber and the people relocated to Fluoruma City. The ruins of Route 14 have a door with an inscription that reads "The Three Protectors will awaken the Titan". Catching the first three Legendary Titans will unlock the door, but this raises questions about what lies beyond. At the end of the route, some Eclipse members were found trying to recruit Rival Tess, who refused their offer.
